Dear Students,

It is being informed to you all that tomorrow on 30th August the school is going to celebrate Raksha Bandhan in different forms. The events will be as follows:

1. House Board Decoration on the theme: **“A small piece of thread has more power than everything”** from Grade III to VII.
2. House-wise Rangoli making on the theme: **“Rakhi is a symbol of Unity in Diversity”**
3. Class-wise Rakhi making: From Nursery to Grade VII. Using any organic materials or craft materials or simply purchased rakhi can also be redecorated by any student.
 - For the Event, No 1 students must not use any thermocol or plastic materials. Students can use paper plates or any other sort of materials that are less costly and easily available. The board must clarify the theme.
 - For Event, No. 2 students can use only 6 colours (Yellow, Green, Orange, Blue, White, and Black). Natural products can be used like rice, sand, or wooden dust to give a better look to the concern theme of each house.
 - Each student can participate in only one event.
 - Each Girl child will bring three readymade rakhis which will be sent to the CRPF Jawans as a regard for their great work for the nation.
 - A few senior girls will be selected to accompany the Principal to regard the CRPF Jawans on 30th August after the dispersal of the school. Those students and their parents will be intimated personally on call.
 - **On 30th August academic classes will not run.** Students are intimated not to bring any books or copies. They will bring only a lunch box, water bottle, and required materials for the above-mentioned events.
 - **The school timing on 30th August will be from 9 am to 12 pm for grades Nursery to Grade VII.**
